





# An interactive group workshop for FE students

#### **WORKSHOP CONCEPT**

Encourage and support students to research their options, share concerns, and discuss any misconceptions or fears about life after GCSEs alongside their teachers and careers advisors, whilst ensuring that they have made informed choices that are most suited to their abilities and interests.

## **BOX CONTENTS**

- 10 Pens
- **30 Mythbuster cards** detailing common misconceptions and fears about College.
- 10 Wildcards blank cards, giving students a chance to add their own worries.
- Mythbusters chart in the form of a games board divided up into three sections:

**RED** I am most worried about...

**AMBER** I am slightly worried about...

**GREEN** I am not really worried about...





# **AGE RANGE**

Mythbuster can be delivered to any number of pupils and is suitable for

Year 8 - Year 11

### **PARTICIPANTS**

Minimum: 12 Maximum: 100

# **DURATION**

#### 50 – 90 mins

Some schools like to play the IEG video first, which is about 10 mins long.

### **WORKSHOP SUMMARY**

- 1. The presenter introduces the workshop, aims and contents.
- 2. The students are divided into small groups of 6 10.
- 3. Each team selects a team leader.
- 4. The team leader reads out each Mythbuster card to their team, and they discuss each card deciding which ones are of most concern and therefore need to be placed in the red section.
- 5. When they have completed this, they are invited to complete their own wild card and asked to give this to the presenter at the end of the session.

- 6. Each team reads out their cards placed in the red section.
- 7. The presenter then reads out every card and responds to each myth.
- 8. At the end of the session, students can privately speak with the presenter and discuss their own concerns that may not have been covered or discuss a general enquiry.
