For research purposes we may also share the data with one or more of the following receiving organisations:

- partner Higher Education providers
- third-party activity providers working with partner Higher Education providers

NCOP and the receiving organisations may then link data to additional educational data. We may also access data and use it to monitor the impact of our HE outreach and recruitment activities.

Any personal data we collect will only be shared with the partners mentioned above. All research publications will be anonymised so individuals cannot be identified and the data will not be used for any other purpose. Data will be processed in accordance with the relevant data protection legislation.
